Applications are invited for the full-time Ph.D. programme in the Department of Literature and Languages, SRM University-AP.

FELLOWSHIP BENEFITS:

- The minimum duration of the programme is three years.
- The research scholar will receive a monthly fellowship of Rs 36,000/- per month for the first two years.
- The scholar will receive **Rs 41,000/-** per month as SRF for the subsequent two years (only if the candidate publishes research papers in Q1/Q2 journals within the two years).

ELIGIBILITY:

Candidates with a Master's Degree in English or related field (55% marks and above) and a valid UGC NET or GATE certificate can apply for a direct interview. Other candidates will have to appear for the Entrance test and Interview to qualify.


